SENATE AMENDMENT "C " to S. P. 914, L. D. 2526, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Certain Election Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 21, § 171, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 171 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read as follows:

When the registrar employs the facilities of the United States Postal Service to determine which voters have moved from the municipality and when the United States Postal Service reports to the registrar that a voter has moved from the address shown on the voting list without having notified the United States Postal Service of a forwarding address, the registrar shall remove the name of such voter from the voting list and shall not be required to send, or to attempt to send, to such voter a notice in accordance with section 172.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 2 to 17 to be sections 3 to 18.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add a new section to provide that when a registrar has used the United States Postal Service to check addresses on the voting list, and has received reports that some voters have moved without a forwarding address, the registrar shall remove these names from the voting list without having to attempt

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to notify all voters whose names have been removed. Such notices must be sent by certified mail, and it would be a useless expense to try to send such notices to persons who have just been reported by the Postal Services to have moved without a forwarding address.
