HOUSE AMENDMENT" A " to S.P. 916, L.D. 2527,
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Dams and Reservoirs."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of
subsection 1 of that part designated "§184." of
section 2 and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'1. Rules and regulations. The bureau may
after public hearing recommend to the Legislature
the adoption, amendment or repeal of such
reasonable regulations as it deems necessary for
the carrying out of this chapter, consistent with
the Administrative Code. '

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment would require
that regulations promulgated by the Bureau of
Civil Defense to carry out the provisions of this
chapter would require legislative approval.
The bill itself grants the bureau emergency
powers to remedy emergency situations without
additional regulations.
