HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1991, L.D. 2535,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Cigarette Tax and  
Provide Funds for Catastrophic Medical Expense."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by inserting in  
the 8th line (same in L.D.) of the 2nd paragraph of  
that part designated "§3454." after the underlined  
word and period "effective." the following new  
sentence: 'The Governor shall determine by proclamation  
when said federal program has become effective.'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by inserting  
at the end of the last line (same in L.D.) the fol-  
lowing underlined sentences: 'Any increase in tax  
authorized under this section shall terminate when a  
federal program similar to that provided in section  
3454 becomes effective. The Governor shall determine  
by proclamation when said federal program has become  
effective.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to terminate  
the program and tax increase to fund the purposes  
of this Act when such program is funded by the Federal  
Government.
