AN ACT Relating to State Purchases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 1816, sub-§ 2, ¶ A, amended. Paragraph A of subsection 2 of section 1816 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 4 of chapter 300 of the public laws of 1969, is further amended to read as follows:

A. The procurement of services, supplies, materials and equipment required ~~in an emergency~~ involves the expenditure of less than ~~\$100~~ \$250 and the interests of the State would best be served thereby;

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill adjusts the limit below which competitive bidding may be waived by the State Purchasing Agent.
