HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 2013, L. D. 2553, Bill, "AN ACT Authorizing Municipal Auditoriums to Have a Liquor License."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 9. R. S., T. 28, §805, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 805 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 166 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Licensed clubs shall sell liquor to members and their guests accompanying them and may sell liquor to the public if the clubs so desire.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to permit licensed nonprofit organizations to have the same privileges as municipalities in selling liquor to the public.
