SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 923, L. D. 2555, Bill, "AN ACT Allowing Incorporated Civic Organizations to Apply for a Liquor License for One Event Per Year."

Amend said Bill in section 10 in that part designated "§801-B." in subsection 3 in the 3rd and 4th lines (same in L. D.) by striking out the following: "at least 20 days in advance of said event or gathering" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'as required by the commission'
