SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A"
to H. P. 2022, L. D. 2565, Bill, "AN ACT
Advancing the Effective Date of a Pay Adjustment
for State, Maine Maritime Academy and Classified
and Unclassified University of Maine Employees."

Amend said Amendment by striking out at
the end, before the Statement of Fact, the
single quotation mark and inserting in place
thereof the following:

Sec. 7. R. S., T. 4, §157, amended. The
4th sentence of section 157 of Title 4 of the
Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced
by section 6 of chapter 509 of the public laws
of 1973, is amended to read as follows:

Each judge shall receive ~~a salary of \$22,000~~
~~for 1973-74~~ and an annual salary of \$23,000
~~thereafter~~; and the Chief Judge shall receive
a salary of ~~\$23,000 for 1973-74~~ and \$24,000
annually ~~thereafter.~~

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to change
the effective date of salary adjustments for
judges to conform with the original bill.
