SENATE AMENDMENT" A "H.P.2037,L.D. 2572,RESOLVE,  
Permitting the County of Kennebec to Expend Money  
for Public Ambulance Service.

Amend said Resolve by striking out all of the  
title and inserting in place thereof the following:  
'RESOLVE, Permitting Kennebec and Hancock Counties  
to Expend Money for Public Ambulance Service.'

Further amend said Resolve by striking out all  
of the 3rd and 4th paragraphs of the Emergency  
preamble and inserting in place thereof the follow-  
ing:

'Whereas, there are many small municipalities  
in Kennebec and Hancock counties which are unable  
to provide funds for such a service , these services  
now being provided by the counties; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally  
necessary to permit the county commissioners of  
Kennebec and Hancock counties to raise money to  
provide such services for the benefit and well-being  
of the citizens in the several municipalities; and'

Further amend said Resolve by striking out all  
of the first paragraph after the Emergency preamble  
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Ambulance service: Kennebec and Hancock  
counties. Resolved: That the County Commissioners  
of Kennebec and Hancock counties are authorized to  
receive and expend funds to provide for public  
ambulance service within their counties; and be it  
further'

Further amend said Resolve by inserting before the Emergency clause, the following:

'Resolved: That the county commissioners of Hancock County are authorized to appropriate both county and federal revenue sharing funds for public ambulance service for Hancock County.'
