SENATE AMENDMENT" A" to S.P. 938, L.D. 2576,
Bill, "AN ACT Establishing the Maine Public Transit

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section
2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated
from the General Fund to the Public Transit Fund the
sum of \$50,000 to carry out the purposes of this
Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
