SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to S. P. 938, L. D.
2576, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing the Maine Public
Transit Fund Act."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part
designated "§4213." by inserting at the end the
following: 'A municipality or group of municipalities
may enter into contractual agreements with existing
private transit companies and, pursuant to
authorization by the Commissioner of Transportation,
may subsidize such private transit companies with
any portion of the state funds expended from the
fund.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify
the bill to allow municipalities that receive
state funds to enter into contractual agreements
with existing private transit companies.
