inserting in place thereof the following: 'receivable

Further amend said Bill by striking out in
the 4th and 5th lines of subsection 1 of that
part designated "§3.308." (same in L.D.) the
following underlined words and punctuation: 'prior
to or within 7 days of the consummation of a
consumer credit sale,'
