SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 2050, L.D.
2584, Bill, "AN ACT Amending the Elderly House-
holders Tax and Rent Refund Act to Improve Benefits."


Amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out
all of that part designated "§6111-A." and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'§6111-A. Participation limitation

No claim shall be granted which is otherwise
allowable under this Part to any claimant who
receives, or to any claimant a member of whose
household receives, benefits paid under supplemental
security income pursuant to Title XVI of the
United States Social Security Act, as amended, or
under state supplemental income pursuant to
Title 22, Part 2, subtitle 3, or any program which
succeeds or supplants it.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to delete
language from the bill that would have created
administrative complications without any
beneficial results to the program.
