HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 2053, L.D. 2588,
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Dredging, Filling or
Otherwise Altering of Rivers, Streams and Brooks."

Amend said Bill by inserting in the 2nd line
of the last paragraph of that part designated "§2207."
(first line in L.D.) after the word "company" the
following underlined words and punctuation: ', a
municipality'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require
a municipality which has its own water system to
receive notice before the department grants a
permit to dredge or otherwise affect a river, stream
or brook which is used as a public water supply.
