SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 2053, L. D. 2588, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Dredging, Filling or Otherwise Altering of Rivers, Streams and Brooks."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 2212." by inserting at the end the following:

'This subchapter shall not apply to emergency repairs, maintenance of railroad structures, track, or roadbed within the located right-of-way of any railroad.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt maintenance and emergency repair work on railroad bridges, trestles, track or roadbed from the requirements of this Act.
