SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 944, L. D. 2590, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Review, Reports and Proposed Amendments of the Maine State Retirement System."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§1005." in subsection 1 in the 5th and 6th lines (4th and 5th lines in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "Council and the Joint Standing Committee on Veterans and Retirement not later than December 1st" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'the Legislature'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§1005." in subsection 2 in the last 2 lines (same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "Council and to the Joint Standing Committee on Veterans and Retirement" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'to the Legislature'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require the Board of Trustees to review the financial condition and operation of the Maine State Retirement System annually and to submit a report of that review with appropriate recommendations to the Governor and the Legislature.
