## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 106TH LEGISLATURE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

HOUSE AMENDMENT"A " to H.P. 2060, L.D. 2592, Bill "AN ACT to Change Weights and Related Provisions for Commercial Vehicles."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 7 the following:

'Sec. 8. R.S.,T. 29, §1703, amended. The first sentence of section 1703 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 22 of chapter 593 of the public laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:

Jurisdiction is vested in the Department of Transportation to grant emergency permits upon proper application in writing to move objects having a length or width or height or weight greater than specified in this Title and for combinations of vehicles not otherwise permitted in this Title over any way or bridge maintained by the Department of Transportation.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering section 8 to be section 9.

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow increased cube capacity of certain motor carriers on special occasions.
