HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 2069, L. D. 2599, Bill, "AN ACT Changing the Membership of the Legislative Ethics Committee."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "1." by striking out all of the first 2 underlined sentences and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The Committee on Legislative Ethics shall consist of 2 members of the Senate appointed by the President of the Senate, 2 members appointed by the minority floor leader of the Senate, 2 members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and 2 members appointed by the minority floor leader of the House of Representatives.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to balance the appointive power between leaders of the respective political parties.
