HOUSE AMENDMENT " D " to S. P. 951, L. D. 2602, Bill, "AN ACT Making Supplemental Appropriations from the General Fund for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1975 and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operation of State Government."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 12 the following:

'Sec. 13. Appropriation.

Reduces appropriation provided in the private and special laws of 1973, chapter 202, Part I Budget, for university operations.

1,000,000

Provides an appropriation for university operations. This appropriation shall be contingent upon the University of Maine Board of Trustees reversing their decision to allow the Wilde Stein Club to use university facilities for their symposium on April 19, 20 and 21.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment reduces the appropriation to the University of Maine in the amount of \$1,000,000 provided in the current services budget and it appropriates an amount of \$1,000,000 to the university contingent upon the board of trustees reversing their decision on the Wilde Stein Club.
