HOUSE AMENDMENT "E " to S. P. 951, L. D. 2602, Bill, "AN ACT Making Supplemental Appropriations from the General Fund for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1975 and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operation of State Government."

Amend said Bill in section 1 under the caption UNIVERSITY OF MAINE by striking out all of that part under "All Other" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'All Other	632,000
------------	---------

Provides \$100,000 for upgrading retirees pensions, and \$212,000 to continue UMA Nursing Course, UMPG Nursing Course, and UMPG Law Clinic. Also to provide \$320,000 to serve approximately 200 additional Maine students enrolled in 2-year programs and increase accessibility of programs at all levels to adults.'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the last line and inserting in place thereof the following:

'TOTAL GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION \$8,156,716'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide funds for students enrolled in 2-year programs at the University of Maine and increase accessibility of programs to adults.
