HOUSE AMENDMENT "G " to S. P. 951, L. D. 2602, Bill, "AN ACT Making Supplemental Appropriations from the General Fund for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1975 and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operation of State Government."

Amend said Bill in section 1 under the caption "MENTAL HEALTH AND CORRECTIONS, DEPARTMENT OF" by inserting before that part relating to Boys Training Center the following:

'40-Hour Workweek

All Other

Personal Services (56) 194,467

Provides for implementation of a 40-hour workweek at correctional institutions to be effective January 1, 1975.

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the last line and inserting in place thereof the following:

'TOTAL GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION

\$8,041,183'
