HOUSE AMENDMENT" I " to S.P. 951, L.D.  
2602, Bill, "AN ACT Making Supplemental  
Appropriations from the General Fund for the  
Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1975 and Changing  
Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the  
Proper Operation of State Government."

Amend said Bill in section 1 under the  
caption MENTAL HEALTH AND CORRECTIONS, DEPARTMENT  
OF by striking out all of the following:

"Probation and Parole	
Personal Services	(5) 40,424
All Other	685

Provides 1 Youth Coordinator  
and 4 additional Probation  
Officers and related expenses."

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by  
striking out all of the last line and inserting  
in place thereof the following:

'TOTAL GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION \$7,795,607'

Statement of Fact

This special session has already referred  
"AN ACT Creating a Division of Youth Services within  
the Bureau of Corrections" to the 107th Legislature.  
The consensus of the Committee on State Government  
was that any Youth Services Program dealing with  
pre-delinquent juveniles and to retard juvenile  
delinquency should be provided from some agency  
outside the Criminal Justice System.
