## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 106TH LEGISLATURE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

HOUSE AMENDMENT "J" to S. P. 951, L. D. 2602, Bill, "AN ACT Making Supplemental Appropriations from the General Fund for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1975 and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operation of State Government."

Amend said Bill in section 1 under the caption HEALTH AND WELFARE, DEPARTMENT OF by striking out all of that part relating to Aid to Families with Dependent Children and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Aid to Families with Dependent Children
All Other 3,101,539

Provides \$3,010,080 to increase AFDC payment maximums 30% effective September 1, 1974; and provides \$91,459 to increase payments to foster parents and residential facilities for care of children by earning federal matching money under the Social Security Act.'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by amending the last line as to TOTAL GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION to reflect the purpose of this amendment.

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to reduce the aid to families with dependent children from \$3,703,555 to \$3,010,080 effective September 1, 1974 rather than July 1, 1974.
