SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 951, L. D. 2602, Bill, "AN ACT Making Supplemental Appropriations from the General Fund for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1975 and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operation of State Government."

Amend said Bill under the caption "EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF" by striking out everything under that part which relates to "Grant, Loan and Scholarship Programs" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'All Other 36,000  
Provides funds for 4 added students at the University of Vermont School of Medicine, and \$16,000 additional for Tufts Dental School.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last line of section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:


'TOTAL GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION \$7,781,716'
