SENATE AMENDMENT " B " S. P. 951, L. D.  
2602, Bill, "AN ACT Making Supplemental Appropriation  
from the General Fund for the Fiscal Year Ending  
June 30, 1975 and Changing Certain Provisions of  
the Law Necessary to the Proper Operation of State  
Government."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part  
relating to "EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL SERVICES,  
DEPARTMENT OF" by adding at the end the following:

'Student Tuition Equalization Fund  
All Other 400,000  
Provides funds to increase the per  
student tuition to \$900 under the  
Student Tuition Equalization Fund'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by  
striking out all of the last line and inserting  
in place thereof the following:

'TOTAL GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION \$8,236,716'
