HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" co S. P. 953, L. D.  
2606, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and  
Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 136  
the following:

'Sec. 136-A. R. S., T. 30, §2061, sub-§3,  
amended. Subsection 3 of section 2061 of Title 30  
of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 6  
of chapter 114 of the public laws of 1969 and by  
section 1 of chapter 265 of the public laws of 1971,  
is further amended by adding after the first  
sentence a new sentence to read as follows:

Nomination papers shall be made available by the  
municipal clerk to prospective candidates during  
the 40 days prior to the final date of filing,  
and before issuance, the town clerk may complete  
each sheet by filling in the name of the candidate,  
the title and term of office which is being sought.'

elections.
