HOUSE AMENDMENT" D" to S.P. 953, L. D.  
2606, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and  
Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 129  
the following:

'Sec. 129-A. R.S., T. 29, §2122, amended. The  
7th paragraph of section 2122 of Title 29 of the  
Revised Statutes, as amended by section 26 of  
chapter 245 of the public laws of 1967, is further  
amended to read as follows:

The Chief of the State Police, a state police  
officer ~~or~~, certain employees of the Motor  
Vehicle Division so designated by the director and  
any municipal police officer may issue a permit  
to owners of motor vehicles which are not inspected  
to enable them to operate such vehicle to an  
inspection station for the purpose of complying  
with this law.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow  
municipal police officers to issue permits for  
uninspected motor vehicle owners to drive their  
vehicles to inspection stations for purpose of  
obtaining the required inspection sticker.
