SENATE AMENDMENT "I" to S. P. 953, L. D. 2606, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 194 the following:

'Sec. 194-A. R. S., T. 37-A, § 41, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 41 of Title 37-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 600 of the public laws of 1973, is amended to read as follows:

All the members of the loan authority board shall be reimbursed for their actual expenses necessarily incurred in the performance of their duties and by a per diem of \$25 for each monthly authorized meeting attended.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment is necessary to authorize payment of a per diem for the several meetings which are necessary during the organization stages of the Maine Veterans Small Business Loan Act.

Seven members of the board are public members and are eligible for per diem payments. The board must work closely with the manager during the next few months in establishing guidelines for prompt utilization of the Maine Veterans Small Business Loan Act.

No additional appropriation is necessary because \$200,000 was authorized for operations in 1973.
