HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to S. P. 957, L. D.
2607, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Mandatory Sentences
for Persons Convicted of Second Offense Breaking,
Entering and Larceny or Burglary."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in the 5th line
(same in L. D.) by inserting after the underlined
figure and abbreviation "2nd" the underlined
words 'or subsequent'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 in the
5th line (same in L. D.) by inserting after the
underlined figure and abbreviation "2nd" the
underlined words 'or subsequent'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to have
the bill apply not only to a 2nd offense but any
subsequent offense thereafter.
