HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to H. P. 2084, L. D.  
2608, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Supplemental  
Security Income."

Amend said bill in section 2 by striking out  
all of those parts designated "§ 3170." and "§3171."  
and by renumbering those parts designated "§3172."  
to "§3184." to be '§3170.' to '§3182.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all  
of sections 7, 8 and 9.

Further amend said Bill by renumbering  
section 10 to be section 7.

Further amend said Bill in the Statement of  
Fact by striking out all of the next to the last  
paragraph.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to strike  
from the bill those sections reconstructing the  
programs currently operated by the Bureau of  
Social Welfare, creating a Bureau of Income  
Supplementation and abolishing the Bureau of  
Social Welfare.
