SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 966, L. D. 2609, Bill, "AN ACT Making Additional Appropriations for the Expenditures of State Government and for Other Purposes for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1974 and June 30, 1975 and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operation of State Government."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 6 the following:

'Sec. 7. P. & S.L., 1971,/§2, amended. The last sentence of section 2 of chapter 86 of the private and special laws of 1971 is amended to read as follows:

The said district is further authorized and empowered to enter into, and to perform under the terms of, contracts, agreements, understandings and other commitments of every kind and description necessary or convenient in connection with the construction and operation of a multi-purpose recreation, athletic and municipal center and further to borrow, mortgage and pledge and issue bonds, notes or other obligations upon such security as the trustees deem necessary or convenient therewith.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to ratify the actions of the trustees of the Cumberland County Recreation Center.
