HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to Joint Order adopting the Joint Rules of the 105th Legislature.

Amend said Order by striking out all of the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'ORDERED, the House concurring, that the Joint Rules of the One Hundred and Fifth Legislature, as amended, be the Joint Rules of this Legislature, with the exception of Joint Rule number 1, paragraphs 1 and 3, and Joint Rulesnumbers 5 and 19, which shall be amended to read as follows:'

Further amend said Order by inserting before the last paragraph the following:

'19. Debate and amendment. No debate or amendment shall be permitted on any bill or resolve until such bill or resolve is before the Senate in the second reading or before the House in the third second reading, provided the favorable report of the committee to which the bill or resolve has been referred has been accepted.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to change the Joint Rules on readings in the House from the 3rd reader to the 2rd reader.
