SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to JOINT HOUSE ORDER
HP 512, Relating to payments to boarding homes
in Maine.

Amend said Order by striking out all of the
5th and 6th paragraphs and inserting in place
thereof the following:

'ORDERED, the Senate concurring, that the
Legislative Council be authorized, through
the Joint Standing Committee on Performance
Audit to immediately review and study the
policies and practices of the Department of
Health and Welfare relating to these payment
differences and report its findings and
recommendations, including all implementing
legislation, regarding these differences to the
Regular Session of the 107th Legislature; and
be it further

ORDERED, that the recommendations shall
consider retroactive payments to boarding homes
that have incurred losses due to existing
policies; and be it further'
