SENATE AMENDMENT " " to/RESOLUTION,
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution
Reducing the Size of the House of Representatives
and Establishing the Size of the Senate.

Amend said Resolution by striking out all
of the 18th and 19th lines (17th and 18th in L.
D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Each Senatorial District shall be comprised
of three contiguous House Districts. Whenever
Representative Districts are reapportioned,
Senate Districts shall be reapportioned.'

Further amend said Resolution by striking
out in the 23rd line (22nd in L. D.) the figure
'1982' and inserting in place thereof the figure
'1984'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify
the intent of the original resolution and to
have the effective date coincide with the release of
Decennial Census data needed for reapportionment.
