**AN ACT to Clarify the Requirements for Voting in Municipal Elections.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 2066 is amended by adding a new sentence to read:

The requirements for voting under Title 21, section 241 shall apply to municipal elections conducted under this Title.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to ensure that any person who is registered to vote on election day or who is enrolled in a party on election day or who is both registered to vote and enrolled in a party on election day may vote in any election for which he is required to be registered or enrolled or both.
