IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Repeal the Requirement for Railroads Operating in Maine to File Annual Reports of Capital Expenditures with the Department of Commerce and Industry.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

35 MRSA § 1251, as amended by PL 1971, c. 584, § 1, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is reflected in the title. The information involved in the report is not ordinarily needed by the Department of Commerce and Industry and is readily available from the Public Utilities Commission, which regularly receives a more comprehensive report of railroad activities.
