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**AN ACT to Repeal Requirements for an Atlantic Salmon Stamp  
under the Fish and Game Law.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACT

The original concept behind the introduction of this stamp was to obtain statistics on where the people came from to fish for Atlantic salmon but due to the irregularities of the coastline it is impossible for enforcement of this section and therefore it should be repealed.
