STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Prohibit Smoking in Certain Areas of Public Buildings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

22 MRSA, § 1577 is enacted to read:

§ 1577. Smoking in waiting rooms, meeting rooms and elevators of public buildings prohibited

Smoking in any waiting room or meeting room or elevator of a public building is prohibited, except when such places are restricted to private use only. Whoever violates this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10 nor more than \$20.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prohibit smoking in certain areas of public buildings.
