COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 19,
L. D. 27, RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment

Amend said Resolution in the 6th and 7th
lines (same in L.D.) by striking out the
underlined words "shall convene after the
adoption of this amendment" and inserting in
place thereof the underlined words 'is in office
at the adoption of this amendment'

Further amend said Resolution in the
9th line (8th line in L.D.) by inserting after
the underlined word "Legislature" the underlined
words and figure 'which convenes in 1983 and'

Further amend said Resolution in the
22nd line (20th line in L.D.) by inserting after
the underlined word "cross" the underlined
words 'municipal or'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to
provide for the most rapid implementation of
single member districts following ratification
by the voters.
