AN ACT to Limit the Purposes for Holding Executive Sessions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

1 MRSA, § 404, is amended by adding a new sentence after the first sentence to read:

Executive sessions may be called for the purpose of discussing proposed or pending litigation, the qualifications of employees to be hired, the reasons for the dismissal of an employee, confidential information pertaining to the administration of public assistance to individuals and for the purpose of collective bargaining, except that all voting shall be done in public.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act will detail the reasons for which executive sessions may be held. The provisions of the amended section will not apply to the Legislature.
