SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to H.P. 24, L.D. 32,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Permit Insurers to Limit Liability  
on Accident Policies in Certain Situations.

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the  
first line after the enacting clause and  
inserting in place thereof the following:

'24-A MRSA §§2721-A and 2721-B are enacted  
to read:'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at  
the end, before the Statement of Fact, the  
following:

'§2721-B. Flight insurance limitation

Any insurance coverage over \$60,000 under a  
policy or policies of insurance issued by an  
insurer or insurers which covers or cover the  
life of any person for the duration of one specific  
journey via aircraft shall be void.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment will limit the amount of  
effective flight insurance on the life of any  
one person for one flight to \$60,000.
