STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Prevent the Department of Transportation from Confiscating or Appropriating Private Water Supply Equipment in Certain Situations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

23 MRSA, § 652, sub-§ 2, ¶ D, as last amended by PL 1971, c. 593, § 22, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

The Department of Transportation shall not condition installation or replacement on the owner giving possession or title of any privately owned piping, tanks, pumps, heating systems or other related fixtures on his land to any agency of this State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to prevent the Department of Transportation from taking privately owned water supply equipment when it furnishes new equipment in conjunction with damage claims arising from road building.
