COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 31, L.D. 39,
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Validity of Absentee
Ballots."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of
section 1.

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by
striking out in the first line the phrase "Sec. 2."

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking
out in the 3rd, 4th and 5th lines (3rd and 4th
lines of L.D.) the underlined words and punctuation
" , or in addition of the notary's seal if the
subscribing official is a notary, "

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove
the requirement that a notary public use his seal
if an absentee ballot is to be valid.
