COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 31, L.D. 39, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Validity of Absentee Ballots."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in the first line the phrase "Sec. 2."

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in the 3rd, 4th and 5th lines (3rd and 4th lines of L.D.) the underlined words and punctuation ",or in addition of the notary's seal if the subscribing official is a notary,"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove the requirement that a notary public use his seal if an absentee ballot is to be valid.
