AN ACT Relating to the Prohibition Against Hitchhiking.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA, § 2188, first sentence, is amended to read:

It shall be unlawful for any person while upon ~~the right of way of any public highway~~ **the traveled portion of any public highway** to endeavor by words, gestures or otherwise, to beg, invite or secure transportation in any motor vehicle not engaged in passenger carrying for hire, unless said person knows the driver thereof or any passenger therein.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act would prohibit hitchhiking on the traveled portion of any public highway.
