STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Commitment of Juvenile Offenders for Habitual Truancy.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

15 MRSA, § 2611, last paragraph, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 522, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

This paragraph shall not apply to habitual truancy by a juvenile under Title 20, chapter 105.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit the juvenile court to sentence a juvenile to a correctional institution for habitual truancy.
