HOUSE AMENDMENT" A "to HOUSE AMENDMENT"A" to  
H.P. 40, L.D. 51, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing  
Special License Plates for the Handicapped."

Amend said amendment by striking out all of  
section 2 and inserting in place thereof the  
following:

'Sec. 2. 29 MRSA §252, 3rd ¶, as enacted by  
PL 1967, c. 218, §1, is amended by adding at the  
end the following new sentence:

Those persons who are found by their physicians  
to have permanent handicaps shall not be required  
to submit annual certificates following their  
initial qualification.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove  
the provision requiring certificates from 2  
physicians as to disability as many small towns  
do not have 2 physicians.
