SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Prohibit Filing of Criminal Cases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

15 MRSA, § 1205 is enacted to read:

§ 1205. Filing of criminal cases prohibited

No judge of the District or Superior Court shall file a criminal case or hold it indefinitely in abeyance.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill will prohibit filing of criminal cases.
