IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Paul R. Nyberg of Mechanic Falls for Motor Vehicle Damage Caused by State Ward.

Paul R. Nyberg; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$1,231 to be paid to Paul R. Nyberg of Mechanic Falls as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damages to his property caused by a state ward.

STATEMENT OF FACT

A 16 year old state ward took Paul R. Nyberg's pickup truck without permission and drove it onto the so-called dump road off Route 26 where he came upon a highway construction crew doing road work. At that point, the ward lost control of the pickup truck which went up a bank and was damaged. Total repair of this damage cost Mr. Nyberg \$1230.91. This resolve will reimburse him for the damage caused by the state ward.
