STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Establishing a Seal for Official Use of the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

3 MRSA, § 5, is enacted to read:

§ 5. Legislative seal

Each Legislature may adopt an official seal for use on legislative correspondence, resolutions, orders, programs and other official documents of the Legislature, but in no event shall the legislative seal be used in lieu of the state seal as provided in Title 1, chapter 9.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the purpose of this Act to provide statutory authority for creation and use of a legislative seal for official business of the Legislature.
