STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Deem the Municipality of Jay to Be Part of the Northern Androscoggin District of the District Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 4 MRSA, § 153, sub-§ 1, 2nd sentence, as enacted by PL 1969, c. 559, is amended to read:

For the purpose of criminal business solely this section, the municipality of Jay, located in the County of Franklin, shall be deemed to be within the District of Northern Androscoggin.

Sec. 2. 4 MRSA, § 153, sub-§ 10, first sentence, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 35, is further amended to read:

Franklin consists of the entire County of Franklin except the municipality of Jay.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act, by allowing Jay residents to conduct District Court business at Livermore Falls instead of Farmington, will save them needless travel and expense.
